Conditions of admission

For registration purposes, your school needs to establish an inter-institutional agreement with ISSIG.

Your school should be able to give you information on this matter. In the unlikely event that your school does not provide you with the necessary information, you may apply for a partnership with ISSIG.

This inter-institutional agreement specifies how many « mobilities » are available between the two schools.

Courses and internships within ISSIG are exclusively in French. Therefore you will need to have achieved a level B1 in French.

Entry procedure

Applications must be submitted before May 15 for the four months starting of the Automn term and before November 15 for the following Spring term.

You should send your completed and signed application to Mme Laurence Raveschot , responsible for the « mobility » at the ISSIG. Your application must include a copy of either identity card or passport.

Further to an assessment of your application, you will receive a mail confirming the decision on your admission.

If you would like further advice on the choice of courses to attend or if you need any further information, please contact Mme Raveschot before submitting your application.

Your next step is to send to ISSIG a Learning Agreement signed by both your school and yourself. After receipt and review, this document will be signed by the director of ISSIG and sent back to you.

This is the final step in the process allowing you to start to begin organizing your visit as you will then receive your access code to ISSIG intranet and to the copy machines.
